



PG&E Mothers' Room Etiquette

Usage Guidelines:

- **Mothers' Rooms are provided to employees for the purpose of expressing milk** (i.e., pumping), in accordance with the California State Bill Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 155 (ACR 155), Chapter 152.
- **Usage of the room must be prioritized to nursing mothers requiring the use of this room.**
- Employees who use the **PG&E-provided breast pump must complete a waiver form** and send to Wellness@pge.com prior to use.

Room Etiquette:

- **Please reserve the time you need to use the room in the Outlook calendar.** This helps nursing mothers to plan accordingly.
 - Save your appointments directly to the calendar with your name in the subject line.
 - Do not mark your appointments private so you may be contacted if a schedule adjustment is needed.
 - Drop-ins are ok, but please check the room/calendar to make sure the room is available. Priority will go to nursing mothers who have reserved the room.
 - Remember to cancel any Outlook appointments you do not plan to use or when you no longer need to express milk.
- PG&E has an obligation to respect the privacy of nursing mothers. **If you need to use the room and it's occupied by another nursing mother** (for single-occupancy rooms):
 - The nursing mother who is scheduled in the Outlook calendar has priority to use the room.
 - You may share the room if both you and the other nursing mother are comfortable doing so.
- **The health and safety of you and your baby is of utmost importance. Please use the wipes provided** in the room to clean up after use to keep the space sanitary
- **To prevent cross-contamination, the refrigerator should ONLY be used to store milk.** Please store your food/drinks in the refrigerator located in your break room.
